Food Grains Bank – Due to the unique nature of this year, there was not a community growing project for 2020. Rather, for this year, individual farmers will donate to Canadian Foodgrains Bank through their grain sales, which is the model CFGB started with. We do not plan for this to be a long-term change, and we expect to go back to our community project next year.
