Why Consent Forms

You may be wondering why the Prairie Rose EM Church requires consent forms for participation in the youth groups and the boys and girls clubs.

Over the last number of years, we have been developing a "Child Protection Policy" with the goal of creating a safer environment for the children who participate in our programs and the adults who lead them. One requirement of this policy is that parents are informed when our children's programs take students off church property and that parents give permission for their children to participate in these activities.

As plans and schedules are made, we also make corresponding consent forms. There are also events that get planned later that require consent and that is what the "Basic (single event) Consent Form" is used for or I may have a consent form designed for a specific date.
